- Ensure proficiency testing and due diligence analysis is carried out and reported.
- Ensure maintenance is carried out on laboratory instrumentation to agreed timescales to ensure accuracy and consistency in analytical results.
- Utilise continuous Improvement technique to improve laboratory and plant performance.
- Support delivery of project work carried out within the Technical team.
- Co-ordinate the Process management systems in the technical compliance area, namely ISO9001:2016, OHSAS18001, ISO 14001, FEMAS (Tullamore) and ensure the area is fully compliant.
