Accountabilities	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Conduct in process quality check validations, incoming material evaluations and finished product inspections to support packaging operations, maintaining all relevant documentation of checks and analysis.Ensure non-conforming products are suitably held in accordance with documented processes to ensure avoidance of being shipped from site.Conduct audits to ensure compliance to quality standards, identifying deviations and support improvement activities with packaging operations.Complete required quality analysis on products/materials and report on findings.Complete required complaint/issue investigations and make recommendations for improvement actions.Perform line audits on glass breakage, record issues found and communicate to relevant line operators and management.Support investigations of quality non-conformances on both product and process with a focus on corrective and preventative action, raising appropriate NCs via IQMSCheck and collate data supporting quality performance measurement and share quality performance data with Line Teams, supporting and participating in improvement activities when required.Support the maintenance of all Quality Standards, Quality Control Plans, SOPs and all relevant quality documents in accordance with the WGW governance structure and the requirements of Q Pulse.Promote and support quality standards in the bottling hall, advising line operators and team leaders on issues relating to product quality.Work collaboratively with peers and colleagues, and apply learnings from identified training and development activities required to perform in role.
